Identify, according to the article, the Spanish-speaking countries for which soy cultivation is a key crop in terms of bioeconomic development.

You will be choosing one of the four Spanish-speaking countries to research and conduct a case study on its specific challenges with respect to soybean production. The United States of America will also be included as a 5th Spanish-speaking country because Spanish is its second most widely spoken language, it is one of the world's largest producers of soybeans, to promote intercultural analysis and communication.

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
