Soil Sampling

What is the procedure for collection of soil samples?

Materials

small shovel or spade bucket (1 or 5 gallon) 1-cup measuring cup sealable bag marking pen

Procedure

The best collection method is to make a composite or mixture of multiple soil samples from different places in a field.

- 1. Use the small shovel or spade to dig up a 2 cup sample of soil at least 4-6 inches below the surface.
- 2. Add it to the bucket.
- 3. Choose another spot in the field; repeat steps a and b.
- 4. Choose a third spot in the field; repeat steps a and b.
- 5. Mix the soil in the bucket together well.
- 6. Bag and label the soil sample with the field name/location.
